



Special liability conditions and information for the PV inverter with integrated battery, Sunny Boy 3600/5000 Smart Energy

- The Sunny Boy Smart Energy is only shipped to SMA-approved countries.
- SMA only provides services and logistics in SMA-approved countries.
- The return and disposal of old batteries takes place in accordance with the relevant country-specific regulations.
- Old and defective batteries should be reported to the SMA Service Line for advice on how to proceed.
- Since batteries are classed as hazardous materials, they must be transported and labeled in accordance with the respective country-specific regulations, e.g., the European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR).
- SMA shall be liable for battery defects and claims from the PV system operator under the SMA factory warranty if and only if the following requirements are met:
 - The specified temperature range for storage and transportation of 18-28°C has been complied with.
 - The equipment and battery have been installed and operated in accordance with the Sunny Boy Smart Energy operating manual and the battery supplementary sheet.
 - The Sunny Boy Smart Energy consisting of inverter and battery has been commissioned at the PV system operator's plant within four weeks of being shipped from SMA. The date and time of commissioning must be documented by a commissioning report or end customer invoice.
